

JEANINE HAHN MEMORIAL REPRESENTATIVE PLAYERS HONOUR BOARD

This Honour Board has been created in memory of Jeanine Hahn, a Life Member and past President who sadly, passed away in 2007.

Jeanine was an elite athlete, being a member of the famous “Dapto Easybeats Team” that won seven consecutive Senior A1 Premierships (now equivalent to the IDNA Premier League Competition) in a row. Not only was Jeanine an elite athlete but she was dedicated to helping as many Dapto players as possible gain representative honours for Illawarra Netball, and higher.

The criteria for determining the names to be recorded on this Honour Board is based on Dapto players being selected in IDNA Representative Teams or Netball NSW Representative Teams.

a. Criteria for Determining Players to be added to the Representative Players Honour Board

A player must comply with the following to be added to the Representative Players Honour Board:

- i) The player must be a primary registration with the Dapto Netball Club as a player.
- ii) The player must be a member of a team of the Dapto Netball Club.
- iii) The player must play at least 3 games with their team in the IDNA Winter competition.
- iv) The player must be selected as a member of an IDNA Representative Team, a member of a NSW Premier League Team in which the IDNA is a partner Association, or, selected as a member of a Netball NSW Representative Team.
- v) A player who has been injured and is unable to play for the Representative Team in which they were selected shall be included on the Honour Board.
- vi) A player who has been dropped from the team for any reason other than injury, shall not be added to the Honour Board.
- vii) A player who leaves the area, or registers with another club, prior to the start of the IDNA Winter competition shall not be added to the Honour Board.
- viii) Players selected in an Illawarra Development Team, or squad, are not eligible to have their name added to the Honour Board.
- ix) Players only selected in an Illawarra Team to play in the Region Championships (or its equivalent) are not eligible to have their name added to the Honour Board.
- x) Players only selected in an Illawarra Team to play in a one-off game are not eligible to have their name added to the Honour Board.
- xi) A player selected with the Illawarra Academy, and not selected as an IDNA representative player, is not eligible to have their name added to the Honour Board.
- xii) A player selected in a schools Representative Team, but not selected as an IDNA Representative Player, is not eligible to have their name added to the Honour Board.
- xiii) A player selected in a Representative Team for any other Association, but not selected as an IDNA Representative Player, is not eligible to have their name added to the Honour Board.

- xiv) A player selected in a Representative Team for any other competition (eg Indoor, Mixed etc), but not selected as an IDNA Representative player, is not eligible to have their name added to the Honour Board.
- xv) Players selected in an IDNA Representative Team for a demonstration game, but not as an IDNA representative player, are not eligible to have their name added to the honour board.
- xvi) An IDNA Representative Team shall be deemed to be a team playing in:
 - a) State Age or State Championships competition (or equivalent)
 - b) Metro League competition (or equivalent)
 - c) Premier League competition for a team with which the IDNA is a partner Association.
