IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All new umpires must complete the following courses through MyNetball and submit certificates to the Umpires Co-ordinator to be able to participate in training and/or games.

- The Rules of Netball Theory Examination (\$11)
 - Foundation Umpire Course (\$40)

Anyone wishing to become a junior umpire must be available to attend coaching and training sessions set by the Umpires Co-ordinator.

Junior umpires should be available from 8.15am on Saturday mornings to umpire for the club, as required by the Umpires Co-ordinator.

Umpire Commitment

Umpiring is a significant commitment by a player to learn the rules of netball and apply this knowledge to competition games. This commitment involves working with the club to develop as an umpire.

To be eligible to be a junior umpire a player **must**:

- Be 12 years of age, or older by the end of 2020.
- Be willing to learn the rules of netball.
- Be committed to applying the rules impartially and to the best of their ability.
- Be prepared to listen and incorporate into their umpiring any feedback received.
- Provide their own whistle, hair elastic and have access to the downloadable rulebook.
- Be willing to attend preseason umpire training sessions.

The Club's Commitment

For every player who is accepted as a junior umpire for the Dapto Netball Club in 2020 the club makes the following commitment:

- To provide coaching and assistance to junior umpires to aid their development as an umpire.
- To act on behalf of any Dapto Netball Club junior umpire should they experience any problems while fulfilling their obligations as an umpire.
- To ensure that all Dapto Netball Club junior umpires are treated with respect.
- To act on any complaints received from a junior umpire relating to their experiences as anumpire.

The Umpires Coordinator will monitor the development of Dapto Netball Club umpires throughout the season. The Umpires Coordinator will monitor Dapto Netball Club umpires ensure they are umpiring ages and grades suitable to their ability.
